Introduction Peer assisted learning (PAL) can be defined as People from similar social groupings, who are not professional teachers, helping each other to learn and learning themselves by teaching (Topping 1996). The key element is that peer teachers are neither content nor teaching experts (Ross and Cameron 2007).

What is PAL? PAL is a student-led initiative that provides a facilitated study session and space where participants can discuss their course, learning and student life in a friendly and informal environment with their peers and trained PAL facilitators.
